Scope and Content

The materials in 2010-0140-S are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

Personnel Management (PE) is subject category containing correspondence, reports of programs affecting federal employees, aggregate personnel reports, speeches, and press releases regarding general personnel matters. Topics discussed include proposed executive orders affecting federal employees such

as furloughs due to budget considerations, requests for political employment, and appeals for presidential support for various issues.

System of Arrangement

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category.
