Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2010-0141-S are a systematically processed body of documents from the White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File category PE001. This secondary category contains correspondence, memoranda, forms, published reports, and newspaper clippings from the Bush administration, particularly White House Counsel's office, the general public, and Congress. Topics

discussed concern personnel matters regarding ethics, including ethical and conflict of interest issues, the Bush administration's ethics reform efforts, and ethics legislation and executive orders. Much of the material consists of routine internal queries and memoranda concerning ethical and conflict of interest issues, and proposed legislation and executive orders. Also included is correspondence from the general public discussing ethics reform, legislation, and ethical scandals.

System of Arrangement

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category.
