Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2010-0254-S are a systematically processed body of documents from the White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File category PE002-01. This secondary category contains correspondence, memoranda, and reports from the Bush administration, the general public, and Congress. Topics discussed include the status of presidential appointments, proposed appointments, recommendations and requests for appointments, proposed executive orders setting the pay level of new executive branch positions, confirmation hearings, recess appointments, and reform of

the confirmation process.

Records from WHORM Subject File category DI002, including memoranda and correspondence on a natural disaster in Maryland, were misfiled in PE002-01 and incidentally processed.

System of Arrangement

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category.
