President Bush: It is a pleasure to have the opportunity for this meeting. I am very anxious to be helpful in any way that we can. (U)

President Aquino: Thank you for your telephone call, even though we were cut off. I told my Filipino friends about being cut off and they couldn't believe it. (U)

President Bush: We do want to work together. The world is offering **some** good opportunities in East-West relations and one reason **we are here** is to show our continuing interest in Asia. Also, I **want** to say that we strongly favor the MAI. (P)

President Aquino: We received your joint statement with Prime Minister Takeshita on the Multilateral Assistance Initiative. Thank you for your support. (P)

Secretary Baker: As you know we are implementing a flexible freeze in our budget process. President Bush has directed that the \$200 million for the MAI be spared from normal budget cutting. This has been done at the President's insistence. (S)

President Bush: We have a very tough budget situation, but I will make a deal with you. I won't tell you all of my problems if you don't tell me all of yours. (S)

President Aquino: Could I ask you one favor? Would it be possible for you to appoint a distinguished American to facilitate the MAI by working with Mr. Villanueva who is here this evening? (S)

President Bush: I will be glad to do so and we will try to give you someone with clout. (U)

President Aquino: That would be most helpful. (U)

The meeting ended with an exchange of pleasantries between President Aquino and Mrs. bush. (U)
