AND PLACE:

Air Force One

King Hussein telephoned the President aboard Air Force One to present him birthday greetings.

After an exchange of pleasantries, <u>King Hussein</u> stated that he was calling to wish the President a very happy birthday. <u>The President</u> replied that it was very thoughtful of the King, and that being 65 years old does not hurt a bit.

<u>King Hussein</u> stated that Queen Noor also sends her love. <u>The President</u> asked if the King was in Amman, to which <u>King Hussein</u> replied in the affirmative.

The President stated that it was very nice of the King to call and indicated that he (the President) had delivered a big environmental message.

After an exchange of courtesies, the call was terminated.
