MEMORANDUM OF CONVERSATION

SUBJECT: Telephone Call from President Turgut Ozal of Turkey

PARTICIPANTS: The President
Turgut Ozal, President
Robert Hutchings, NSC Staff (Notetaker)

DATE, TIME August 8, 1990, 3:38 - 3:40 p.m.
AND PLACE: The Oval Office

President Ozal initiated the call.

President Ozal: I saw you on CNN. You were very good.

The President: I hope I didn't embarrass you by singling out Turkey.

President Ozal: Not at all, Mr. President. You looked tired.

The President: Not really. I'll be all right. As you know, Jim Baker will be coming to Turkey.

President Ozal: I will be looking forward to it.

The President: He'll be there to give our steadfast assurance of support.

President Ozal: I will welcome his ideas. We can also talk about future steps.

The President: Right. He will also want to hear your views. But I feel fine. I'm going out now to get a little exercise, to play some tennis. I am also strengthened by your courageous stance in all this.

President Ozal: Thank you, Mr. President.
