PARTICIPANTS: The President  
King Hussein  
Notetaker: C. David Welch

DATE, TIME August 13, 1990, 6:18 - 6:20 p.m. EDT  
AND PLACE: Kennebunkport

The President initiated the call. (U)

The President: Back again, sir. If you can come fairly soon, we can have lunch in Washington on Wednesday (August 15) or meet in the afternoon. If that's not convenient, we will have to get back to you with some alternative suggestions. (U)

King Hussein: Can I look at that possibility and call you back tomorrow? (U)

The President: If that's not convenient, we'll work something out for another time. (U)

King Hussein: I'll get back to you or leave a message, as soon as possible. (U)

The President: If I'm not here, talk to Brent Scowcroft in Washington. (U)

King Hussein: Of course. You know, it's 1:20 a.m. here -- I'll need to check a few things in the morning. (U)

The President: OK, goodbye. (U)
