SUBJECT: President's Telephone Call to King Fahd

PARTICIPANTS: The President  
King Fahd

DATE, TIME: May 11, 1991; 6:03 - 6:06 p.m.  
AND PLACE: Camp David

The President: Hello, Your Majesty. This is George Bush. How are you? (U)

King Fahd: Very good. How is your health? (U)

The President: Good. I am at Camp David resting. I plan to take Monday off. But my health is perfect. (U)

King Fahd: Thanks be to God. I saw that on CNN. (U)

The President: So everything is okay. I am calling to thank you for the announcement today. It is a marvelous step forward. I know it wasn't easy. It should make Jim Baker's trip easier.

King Fahd: I am ready for you to do anything. (Ø)

The President: I will be consulting with you on next steps once he gets back. (Ø)

King Fahd: Very good. (U)

The President: One other thing, I hope you are still planning to come here. (Ø)

King Fahd: Yes, of course. (U)

The President: Very good. I look forward to it. Thank you again. (U)

King Fahd: Thank you and good-bye. (U)
