Shamir of Israel (U)

AND PLACE: The Oval Office

Prime Minister Shamir initiated the call. (U)

The President: Hello. (U)

Prime Minister Shamir: Hello, Mr. President. (U)

The President: How are you? I am very pleased with the way it went in New York. It is a great achievement for you. We had a lot of help. The vote was overwhelming. (U)

Prime Minister Shamir: All of our people remember your speech. (U)

The President: Our people worked hard but had tremendous help. I am so pleased for Israel. This removed a scar that should not have ever been there. (U)

Prime Minister Shamir: We are so very grateful. I want personally to express our thanks and appreciation. (U)

The President: Thank you. It was a team effort. I'd like to say publicly that you called to express your appreciation to the United States. (U)

Prime Minister Shamir: Thank you again and God bless you. (U)
