The President: Carlos, como esta? (U)

President Menem: I'm fine. (U)

The President: What is going on? Is there a problem? (U)

President Menem: I called because I was worried about your health. I wanted to talk to you to be sure everything was all right. I saw the pictures of you getting sick. Barbara was magnificent. She handled the situation beautifully. (U)

The President: When I throw up, I do it in a spectacular way, you have to admit. I do it with flair. (U)

President Menem: It certainly was a sight. I hope it doesn't happen again. You scared us to death. (Ø)

The President: Let me say a serious word about that. Because of the dramatic way it hit me, it got the attention of the whole world, but it was strictly the 24 hour flu. When that time was over, and even sooner, I picked up my schedule. I went to a State Dinner given by the Emperor. I didn't feel like eating very much, but I felt strong and steady. Since then, I have had a series of tests, including the EKG, blood tests, blood pressure, and so on, and they all turned out fine. I am a very, very lucky guy. (Ø)

President Menem: This is wonderful news. We have to continue to travel down the same path together for the sake of the region, and I know that you will continue with the same courage and resolve you have shown until now. You know I will do anything you ask, just let me know how I can help. Let me know what attitude you would like me to assume. (Ø)

President Menem: Thanks so much. An abrazo for you, a kiss for Barbara, and a huge one for the grandchildren. Don't forget, if there is anything I can do, I will do it. You have only to ask me. (Ø)

The President: An abrazo to you. Thanks for the call. Good bye. (U)
