MEMORANDUM OF TELEPHONE CONVERSATION

SUBJECT: Telcon with Prime Minister Shamir of Israel (U)

PARTICIPANTS: The President Yitzak Shamir, Prime Minister Notetaker: Bruce Riedel, NSC

DATE, TIME May 10, 1992; 7:05 - 7:08 a.m. AND PLACE: The White House

President Bush: How are you? (U)

<u>Prime Minister Shamir</u>: I am fine Mr. President. I am very happy to hear your voice. (U)

<u>President Bush</u>: There is much going on with the elections in both our countries. I have been in Los Angeles. I am glad we could get together on the phone. (U)

<u>Prime Minister Shamir</u>: I was very excited by your message to Israel on Independence Day. (U)

<u>President Bush</u>: I am glad to hear that. It was nice of you to call. (U)

<u>Prime Minister Shamir</u>: I want to thank you for all you have done for us Mr. President, especially on the immigration of our brothers from Russia and Ethiopia. You are a great humanitarian.  $(\not Q)$ 

<u>President Bush</u>: I am glad you said that. I know there are many strains in our relationship today, but I believe there is much more that is positive.  $(\mathscr{C})$ 

<u>Prime Minister Shamir</u>: We pray for you here in Israel and for your success. We are sure you will get your goal.  $(\mathcal{C})$ 

<u>President Bush</u>: Well thanks for that thought. It is a strange political year here -- not a pleasant one, and your prayers are appreciated. Thank you for calling. ( $\not c$ )

<u>Prime Minister Shamir</u>: One more thing, Mr. President. We are dedicated to the peace process. We want to continue the momentum and we want no interruption in the process.  $(\mathcal{Q})$
