

The President: That's fine. Where did I find you, in Istanbul?

(Ø)

Prime Minister Demirel: No, in Ankara. I go to Istanbul tomorrow, I have Nazarbayev with me. (Ø)

The President: Please give him my regards. He's a good man.

Prime Minister Demirel: I will. I would like to say that I think something should be done regarding Bosnia. It is a very bad situation. (Ø)

The President: I agree. We sent a carrier group there as a symbol of our seriousness on this issue. Any time you have
