REQUEST: Meeting with President Mitterrand

PURPOSE: To continue the close working relationship and to coordinate strategy on Iraq.

BACKGROUND: President Mitterrand will deliver an address at the UN the morning of September 24, flying in and out on the Concorde the same day. He has let it be known informally through his Chief of Protocol that he would be most receptive to an invitation to see the President in Washington, but he does not want to be in the position of making a formal request.

SUBJECT: Mitterrand Schedule Proposal

Ambassador Gadeau, the French Chief of Protocol, has told Joseph Reed that Mitterrand would be very receptive to an invitation to come to the White House on Monday afternoon, September 24. Mitterrand plans to fly in from Paris that morning on the Concorde to address the UNGA. He will return to Paris the same day.

Mitterrand has responded extremely well to the President's frequent phone calls on the Iraq/Kuwait crisis. A visit in person would be just the right touch at this point, both to further consolidate his support on the Gulf and to set a more positive tone for dialogue on NATO after the distancing which occurred at the London Summit.
