Dear John:

Following last week's NAC meeting, one of our Foreign Agricultural Service officials was dispatched to Baghdad to negotiate the additional GSM export credit approved for the Government of Iraq. This note is just to let you know how it worked out: Iraq accepted our offer to extend \$500 million in new GSM-102 guarantees. Iraq did not request a commitment at this time for a second tranche of credit. However, it is our intent to provide up to an additional \$500 million in new GSM-102 guarantees provided the original \$500 million is utilized and no improprieties or irregularities are discovered in connection with Iraq's involvement in the program.

This arrangement with the Iraqis will give us additional time and flexibility in reviewing any new facts surfacing as a result of the Atlanta investigations. Please keep in mind that this program can and will be suspended any time improprieties are discovered.

Thanks for your help in moving this issue along towards a reasonable and responsible disposition.
