

Dear Mr. President:

The National Association of Arab Americans (NAAA) is deeply disappointed by the escalation of the conflict between Iraq and Kuwait. We support your decision to freeze Iraqi assets in the United States and to prohibit business transactions with Iraq. We ask you to direct all diplomatic and economic efforts in pursuit of a peaceful resolution to the conflict. However, we urge that you avoid unilateral actions which may only exacerbate the situation.

We call upon the United States government to cooperate fully with the international community including the United Nations Security Council and the Arab League to support political initiatives aimed at defusing this crisis.

NAAA has been and remains historically committed to the peaceful resolution of all conflicts in the Middle East, whether among the Arab states or between Arabs and Israelis. We reaffirm our support for the principle of the inadmissibility of the acquisition of territory by force, and for the independence, sovereignty, and territorial integrity of Kuwait.

We are hopeful for an immediate cease-fire and the withdrawal of all Iraqi forces to the international borders.

Thank you for your consideration.
