Dear Mr. President:

We are writing on behalf of the National Jewish Coalition to express our support for your response to the Iraqi invasion of Kuwait.

Saddam Hussein's unprovoked conquest of a peaceful neighboring state confirms him as a dangerous and destabilizing force in the Middle East. History has taught us that the threat a dictator such as Hussein poses to his neighbors in the Gulf and to U.S. interests in the region cannot be averted by soft words or by inaction. We therefore commend you for your firm response to this latest crisis.

Your leadership role in rallying the nations of the free world behind a comprehensive program of economic sanctions is also commended. We believe that you are pursuing a prudent course by focusing on economic rather than military options at this time. Yet at the same time, we appreciate that other options may have to be considered if Iraqi aggression turns against Saudi Arabia or another Gulf state, or if Hussein threatens or harms American citizens in the region.

The National Jewish Coalition supports your resolute stand against the Iraqi invasion of Kuwait. We encourage you to continue every effort to turn Iraq away from this aggression.
