SIGNED ORIGINAL WILL FOLLOW. WHILE THE WHITE HOUSE DOES  
NOT INTEND TO MAKE THE TEXT OF THE LETTER PUBLIC, IT HAS  
NO OBJECTION TO THE GOG DOING SO IF IT WISHES.

2. BEGIN TEXT:

DEAR MR. PRIME MINISTER:

THANK YOU FOR YOUR LETTER OF AUGUST 9 WITH ITS STATEMENT  
OF FIRM RESOLVE IN COUNTERING IRAQI AGGRESSION AND  
RESTORING THE TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY OF KUWAIT. I BELIEVE  
THAT CONSIDERABLE PROGRESS HAS BEEN MADE IN ORGANIZING  
MULTINATIONAL EFFORTS TO ACHIEVE THAT GOAL. I WELCOME AND  
DEEPLY APPRECIATE GREECE'S CONTINUING COOPERATION IN THE  
ENDEAVOR TO RESTORE PEACE UNDER INTERNATIONAL LAW IN THE  
GULF.
