Dear President Bush:

The Jewish Federation of Greater Dallas Community Relations Council (CRC) is writing to express its support of your efforts to reverse the actions of Saddam Hussein.

The Persian Gulf crisis has been precipitated by the aggression of a large, well-armed country against a smaller neighbor. These actions are the first threat to world peace in the post-cold war era. It is gratifying that the international community has responded in a unified show of support in this crisis.

We applaud the firm words and strong actions undertaken by the United States government to protect national security, economic and international interests in the Persian Gulf.

The Dallas CRC encourages the administration to continue advocating such measures against the Iraqi regime. President Hussein has demonstrated through his war with Iran, his deplorable human rights abuses and take-over of Kuwait, that he is the primary threat to peace and stability in the Middle East.

The situation must be resolved quickly before President Hussein can increase his political, economic, chemical warfare and nuclear threat to the world.
