Dear Mrs. Whitlock,

Thank you for your recent message to Mrs. Bush, which has just reached her office. She appreciates your taking the time to write and communicate your views.

Mrs. Bush shares your deep concern over the use of force and repression by the Government of Iraq against Kurdish and other Iraqi civilians. By now you may know that, at President Bush's direction, the United States initiated what soon became the largest U. S. relief effort mounted in modern history. Temporary encampments, supplies, other forms of humanitarian assistance, and protection for the Kurds are being provided by the international coalition. The President has made it clear that the United States is committed to assisting those who are suffering and to helping restore stability to the Persian Gulf region.

I know Mrs. Bush would want me to convey her best wishes to you.
