
Dear Betty and Emile:



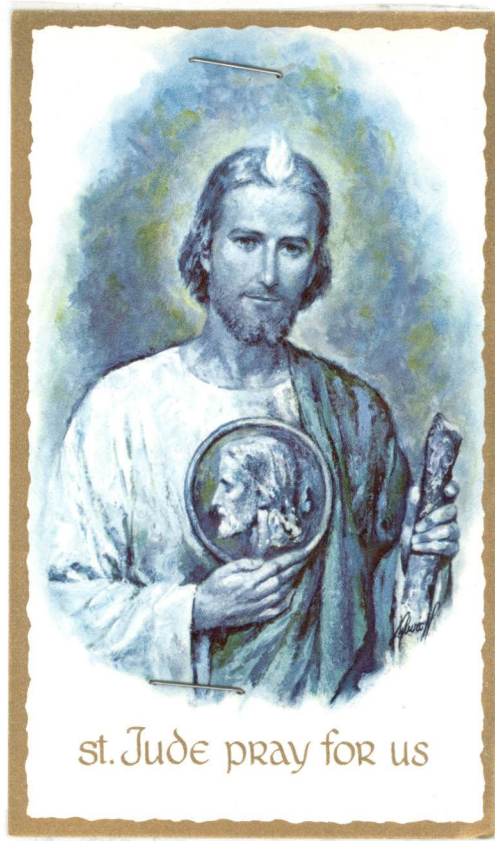
