

Dear Mr. Chairman:

Thank you for your thoughtful letter of October 31, 1991 on Iraq. Your support for the policy of keeping pressure on Iraq is much appreciated. As the President has said on several occasions, the United States is determined to maintain sanctions against Iraq and continue promoting its diplomatic isolation until there is a change of leadership in Baghdad. (C)

We have increased our contacts with the Iraqi opposition in the last six months. As you know, the opposition remains internally divided. There are more than sixty different groups that we are aware of. The United States has encouraged the various elements of the opposition to work together more effectively. (S)



Let me again thank you for your support for the struggle against Saddam. We will continue to review our options from time to time and would welcome any additional thoughts you might have. (C)
