Dear Mr. President:

This coming Monday, the United Nations Security Council will consider a resolution on Israel. We understand that the U.S. will try to postpone consideration of this resolution until after January 15th. If, however, the postponement strategy is not successful the U.S. will have to decide whether to veto or abstain on this resolution.


We commend you for your strong statements rejecting Saddam Hussein's attempts to link Iraq and Israel. We strongly believe that should a vote become necessary, whether now or in a few weeks, that the United States should continue our no-linkage policy by vetoing this resolution.

We are concerned that allowing the passage of any anti-Israel resolution, *even a weakened version of the pending resolution*, could be viewed as a concession to Iraq. Conversely, a U.S. veto would show that the U.S.-led coalition is strong enough to withstand disagreements on extraneous issues.


A veto would avoid a series of resolutions built on inevitable Israeli non-compliance with this resolution. If the U.S. abstains, a veto will not be avoided, but postponed to a time when it may become even more difficult to exercise.

The proponents of the pending resolution are using the Palestinian issue to undermine U.S. policy in the Gulf. We must not allow this cynical manipulation of the U.S. and the United Nations to succeed. We thank you for your consideration, and look forward to working with you on such matters in the future.






