REQUEST: For an official working visit by the Amir of Kuwait with the President.

PURPOSE: To discuss the current Iraqi occupation of Kuwait and to thank the GOK for its financial support for our military deployment.

BACKGROUND: Earlier this month the President spoke with the Amir and told him he would look forward to seeing him if he were to visit Washington. Secretary Baker recently conveyed this sentiment to the Amir when he met with him in Taif, Saudi Arabia on September 7. The Amir will be in New York on September 24 to address the UN General Assembly. Following that, he is prepared to come to Washington to meet with the President to personally thank him for all the United States is doing to liberate Kuwait, and to discuss the current situation.
