

I am responding on behalf of President Bush to your kind cable of August 4 concerning the United States' stand on the Iraqi invasion of Kuwait. Your country also deserves congratulations for its principled stand in support of the United Nations resolutions. The President and Congress have commended Bangladesh for its decision to respond to Saudi Arabia's request for military assistance.

As the struggle to force Iraq to withdraw from Kuwait continues we are counting on continued international solidarity until we have reached the goals of complete Iraqi withdrawal and the restoration of Kuwait's sovereignty.
