Dear Mr. Edhi:

Thank you for your telegram to President Bush of September 9 in which you stress the need to assist displaced persons of all nationalities who are fleeing Iraq and Kuwait. Please be assured that this humanitarian emergency is of great concern to the United States government.

Since August 2, as many as one million people have fled Iraq and Kuwait. The international community responded quickly to the emergency; donor countries and organizations have so far contributed over USD 200 million in cash and in-kind aid, including food, aircraft, medicines, and shelter. Countries to which the displaced have fled; principally Jordan, Turkey, and Saudi Arabia; have, with international support, made impressive efforts to care for them. While camp conditions have at times been harsh, there have been few deaths, no reports of starvation or epidemic disease, and repatriation of the displaced to their home countries is proceeding smoothly. The relief effort on their behalf has so far been a success.

The United States has committed up to USD 28 million to the international assistance program for the displaced persons. USD 10 million is committed to the repatriation program which, coordinated by the International Organization for Migration, assists the displaced in returning to their home countries. The remaining USD 18 million will provide for food aid and cash contributions for other humanitarian assistance. Finally, U.S. military aircraft have on several occasions helped to transport emergency supplies and are scheduled to assist in the repatriation of some of the displaced.

I hope the above information will be useful to you. Thank you very much for your interest and concern.
