Thank you for your recent letter alerting me to the dilemma confronting Professor John Norton Moore because of his chairmanship of the Peace Institute. I have had a member of my staff look into the matter, and Boyden Gray has discussed the problem personally with Professor Moore.

Unfortunately, I do not think we will be able to help him. Professor Moore has decided not to seek a waiver under the relevant ethics law, and because of the commercial nature of his prospective relationship with the Kuwaiti government, we cannot effectively endorse him to the Kuwaitis by encouraging him to resign his position with the Peace Institute.

Again, thank you for bringing this matter to my attention.

Dear John:

Professor John Norton Moore recently was asked by Ambassador Shaikh Saud Nasir Al Sabah of Kuwait to form and chair a group to advise Kuwait on legal issues. You may recall that Moore crushed the Iraqi Ambassador in a television debate a few months ago.

The problem is that Moore is Chairman of the Peace Institute, a Presidential appointment. Under the new ethic laws, he may not be able to advise the Shaikh while serving as a part-time government employee. Moore is normally a Professor at the University of Virginia and Dean of the Graduate Program there.

Moore informed the Ambassador that he was willing to resign the Chairmanship (or temporarily vacate the post) but felt that he could only do that if encouraged to do so by the White House. My understanding is that the Ambassador indicated that he would raise the matter with President Bush. You may want to check these facts with Moore (804 924-7441).

In any case, Kuwait badly needs legal advice, particularly on international law and Moore is a strong backer of the President. It seems obvious that it would be in your office's interest to have some one such as Moore advising the Shaikh. Again, feel free to check out how the Ambassador sees the situation (202 966-6731).
