

On Sunday, March 17, the Montgomery County Masonic Conference is sponsoring a Patriotic Rally, to honor all members of the U.S. Military Forces who served in Operation Desert Storm. As Commander in Chief and Leader of our Nation, we would like to invite you to be ~~primary~~ Speaker for this occasion.

The more than 76,000 Alabama Masons and Eastern Star members have chosen this event as a way of honoring our Alabama National Guard, our Reservists, and the Regular Military from this state who served in the war.
