Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Bush Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Copyright

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (Title 17, USC) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.

Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Processed By

Staff Archivists, 1996–1997. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

Scope and Content

The materials in FE003 (Executive Orders) are a systematically processed body of documents from the White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File. This secondary subject category contains materials relating to executive orders. Constituents write in requesting executive orders addressing specific issues (for instance, an E.O. banning the importation of semi-automatic assault rifles into the U.S.), proposed executive orders are set forth within the government (Administration of Foreign Assistance and Related Functions and Arms Export Controls), and the Counsel's Office offers advice on tentative executive orders. Some examples of executive orders (a few of which Bush eventually issued) are as follows: to return Haitian refugees to Haiti without giving them a chance to ask for political

asylum; to declassify and publicly release all documents, files, and other records relating to American MIAs/POWs; to remove all pornographic magazines from American military installations.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category.
