Scope and Content

The materials are a systematically processed body of documents from the White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File category ND004-01.

The materials in WHORM category ND004-01 (Manpower, Military) consist of unclassified and declassified cover sheets from the White House and National Security Council, which route correspondence. The correspondence includes letters to the President from Congressmen, local government officials, and citizens requesting that specific troops be brought home from the Gulf, suggesting that single parent military personnel with minor children not be deployed to the Gulf, and supporting the administration's proposed cuts in conventional forces in Europe.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this systematic review were found in Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category.
