#### **Scope and Content**

The materials in SC (Sciences) are a systematically processed body of documents from the White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File. A subject category containing information and research materials on alternative fuels, fossil energy, geothermal energy, recycling, cold fusion, the use of aerosols, ozone, the effects of chlorofluorocarbons (CFC), global climate change and global warming, the Superconducting Super Collider, human fetal tissue research, fetal cell transplants, and biomass/MSW conversion to renewable energy. It also contains reports including *The Farm Animal & Research Facilities Protection Act of 1989*, Electromagnetic Fields Research & Information Dissemination, Our Changing Planet: The FY 1991 U.S. Global Change Research Program, and The President's Council on

Competitiveness: Report & National Biotechnology Policy.

### **System of Arrangement**
