Scope and Content

The materials in TA005 (Trade Agreements) are a systematically processed body of documents from the White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File. This secondary subject category contains trade agreements made by the United States with other countries. This category contains correspondence from legislators, trade groups, industry groups, and representatives from other countries. Also in this category are decision memoranda and other correspondence from members of the Bush Administration. Some of the issues found in this category include the debate over Most Favored Nation (MFN) status for the People's Republic of China, trade agreements with the Soviet Union, the Canadian Free Trade Agreement (CFTA), and the negotiations among the United States, Canada, and Mexico for

the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA).

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category.
