Scope and Content

The materials are a systematically processed body of documents from the White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File category NR007-01.

NR007-01 is a secondary subject category containing government forms, reports, and correspondence. There are letters from Anna Allebach, Terry Hershey and Phyllis Inloes concerning Houston bayou projects such as the Addicks and Barker Reservoirs and the 100 year flood plain. There is also letters between the White House and Idaho State Senator Bruce Sweeney concerning Bonneville Dam. Finally, there are letters and reports concerning plans for a turbine dam in Fort Dodge, Iowa.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this systematic review were found in Bush Vice Presidential WHORM Subject Files.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category.
