Scope and Content

The materials in WE003 (Family Planning) are a systematically processed body of documents from the White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File. The bulk of this secondary subject category is comprised of correspondence between the President and organizations, individuals, corporations, and Congressmen supporting and criticizing the President's right-to life position. This category also includes correspondence, enrolled bills, fact sheets, proposed testimony, reports, and memoranda concerning teen pregnancy, the judiciary and abortion, strengthening families, rape and incest, federal funding of abortions, the Washington D.C. appropriations bill, RU 486, parental notification for abortions, the Title X Pregnancy Counseling Act, the Family Unity and Employment Opportunity

Immigration Act of 1990, the Wichita, Kansas abortion clinic siege, population control, and the Family Planning Amendments Act of 1992.
