#### **Extent**

#### **Access**

#### **Scope and Content**

The materials are a systematically processed body of documents from the White House Office of Records

Management (WHORM) Subject File category CO111.

CO111 is a secondary subject category containing government forms, correspondence, and remarks. There are letters from the public to the White House concerning the proposal to legalize euthanasia in the Netherlands. There is also a copy of the remarks given by Prime Minister Ruud Lubbers at Georgetown University in 1989. Forms and memos in this category transmit routine correspondence.

**System of Arrangement**

Records that are responsive to this systematic review were found in Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files; Bush Vice Presidential WHORM Subject Files.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category.
