Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2010-0038-S are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

CO122 is a secondary subject category containing government forms, correspondence, lists, and unclassified biographies. There are letters from Moses Werror, chairman of the OPM Revolutionary Council in West Papua Niugini to President Bush, the prime minister of the Netherlands and the president of the Republic of Indonesia which address the desire for independence from Indonesian military government occupation. There are also memos which discuss a meeting between President Bush and Prime Minister Rabbie Namaliu. The lists reflect the participants of this meeting. Lastly, there are unclassified biographies of cabinet-level Papuan government officials.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this systematic review were found in Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category.
