Scope and Content

The materials in FA004 (Housing) are a systematically processed body of documents from the White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File. This secondary subject category contains materials relating to federal funds for housing. The primary focus of the documents within this file code involve pleas on the part of prominent public officials for the Bush Administration to provide the appropriations necessary to maintain their many housing programs at full effectiveness. Among the projects discussed in some degree are the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), Urban Development Action Grant (UDAG), Comprehensive Improvement Assistance Program (CIAP), and Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) program. In addition, a number of correspondents try to make a

convincing case for the full funding of the Emergency Community Services Homeless Program (EHP) under the McKinney Act.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category.
