Japan Cooperative Medical Science Program; Family and Medical Leave Act of 1992; National Organ Donor Transportation Program; Native Hawaiian Health Care Act of 1988; Health Care for People Over 65 - Senior Citizens; Safe Medical Devices Act; National Marrow Donor Program, and Health, U.S., 1988 & 1989.
