Scope and Content

The materials in HE003 (Nutrition – Hunger) are a systematically processed body of documents from the White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File. This secondary subject category contains documents on programs and issues including: ionizing radiation to control food poisoning from poultry; Red Dye #3; Nutrition Labeling & Education Act of 1990; President's Food Safety Initiative; health safety warning for food; National Nutrition Monitoring Advisory Council; Agency for International Development - Campaign to End Hunger; Bread for the World Policy Paper "No Child Should Go Hungry;" "Ending Hunger Through Sustainable Development;" symposium to discuss hunger and world need; The Mickey Leland Memorial Hunger Relief Act; concerns for free lunches to all children; Operation Desert

Share - Food Bank; The Hunger Emergency Assistance & Relief Trust Act; Report on the 1989 Prime Time to End Hunger Campaign; Ending Hunger The Cyprus Initiative; Reduce Hunger in the Horn of Africa - The Horn of Africa Recovery & Food Security Act, and World Hunger - Resolution "Harvest of Peace".
