Topics included are: Financing health care for the uninsured; Ford Motor Company Report; "Financing the U.S. Health Care System - The Effect of Rising Health Care Costs on American Competitiveness;" professional liability on the cost of health care; "Investing in America's Future: Financial & Economic Implications of an Aging Society;" views on 30 to 40 million Americans who have no access to health care; Health Care in America is in the Midst of a Crisis by the Huntington Chiropractic Clinic; Consolidated Maternal & Child Health Services Act

of 1989; The Cheshire Medical Center regarding some perspectives on health care Americares; The 1990 Annual Report on the Indian Health Service Health Facilities Construction Priority System; Waiver for Oregon Basic Health Services Act; Trauma Care Systems; Planning & Development Act of 1990; Annual report of the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation; A Surgical Perspective by Dr. Michael E. Debakey, M.D.; employee health plans; home dialysis treatments; and health care reform.
