Scope and Content

The materials in HE006-01 (Narcotics) are a systematically processed body of documents from the White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File. This secondary subject category has information on drug abuse and drug abuse programs. Topics include: "Drug Tests for the Drug Testers;" drug education for young people; Ameri-Care; D.A.R.E. (Drug Abuse Resistance Education); Living Hope Mime Team; "Illegal Drugs - A Treating Psychiatrist's View;" Dallas Can! Saving Dallas County Kids; Establishing a Drug Free Federal Workplace; Drugs, Law Enforcement and Foreign Policy; Get Hooked on Fishing! Not Drugs!; Just Say No Programs; Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988 & 1990; The National Drug Control Strategy Implementation Act of 1990; International Narcotics & Terrorism Control Act of 1989 &

1990; Drug and Alcohol Dependent Offenders Treatment Act; Report of the Texas Criminal Justice Task Force; a report from the neighborhood "Peer Pressure Club" - [How to Stop Drugs](#); Cocaine use among blacks and whites; Wilson-Heinz Provisions of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988; and "Partnership for Youth Program" from the Eckerd Family Youth Alternatives.
