#### Scope and Content

The materials in HE007 (Pollution Control – Sanitary Services) are a systematically processed body of documents from the White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File. This secondary subject category contains information about the environment and sanitation. Topics include: "Decision Makers Guide to the Greenhouse Effect;" environmental protection rules; National Bottle Deposit Bill; "Intolerable Risk" - a report on pesticides in food; "The Solid and Hazardous Waste Problem;" the global problem of pollution; The Clean Air Act; The Mandated Asbestos Hazard Abatement Act of 1984; substances that deplete our ozone layer; mercury & lead pollution; Oil Pollution Act of 1990; National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit Application Regulations for Storm Water Discharges; The

Hazardous Waste Law; aircraft noise levels; regulations concerning sulfur dioxide; "Calculations of Carbon Mass Equivalents;" regulations that apply to incinerators; Hydrogen Energy Coordinating Committee's Annual Report - Summary of Department of Energy Hydrogen Programs for Fiscal Year 1988; and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Proposed Hazardous Waste Identification Rule
