Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Scope and Content

The materials in IS001 (Accident - Hospital - Medical - Health - Medicare - Medicaid) are a systematically processed body of documents from the White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File. This secondary subject category contains documents relating to Workmen's Compensation, National Childhood Vaccine Compensation Implementation Act of 1989, health insurance tax reductions for self-employed, health insurance fraud, Health Insurance Market Reform Act of 1992, Radiation Exposure Compensation Act, State Health Insurance, employee's compensation appeals, no cost health insurance

to servicemen, unemployment insurance for ex-service members, retired employees health programs, the Pepper Commission, and unemployment insurance benefits. This category also covers information on all matters concerning Medicare and Medicaid such as funding, physicians' payment reform, and fee schedules. There is also information on the Catastrophic Coverage Act of 1988, Home Intensive Care Inc., and disability insurance benefits.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category.
